

Responding to Incident Reports Risk of Harm / Disclosures



Someone advises you of a disclosure, or raises concerns regarding the immediate welfare of a child.



Help the person who has received the disclosure, or is raising the concern to complete an Incident Report – Risk of Harm. Reassure, and provide appropriate care for the person receiving the disclosure.

Safe Churches

Remember: When Receiving a Disclosure DO

- 1. LISTEN You will need to write down exactly what was said
- KEEP IT BRIEF Close the conversation down quickly. This is not the only time the child will have to share their story and you may actually harm an investigation.
- REASSURE Let them know they have done the right thing in telling you.
- INFORM Let them know what needs to happen you will need to tell someone who can help.

- DO NOT INVESTIGATE THE DISCLOSURE You don't need to prove this. Don't ask leading questions.
- DO NOT DISMISS THIS Children rarely lie about such matters.
- 3. DO NOT MAKE PROMISES You may not be able to stop the abuse.
- 4. DO NOT SHARE You cannot tell anyone who does not need to know.
